GENERAL:

Please note all of our rates must be read in conjunction with our lodge fact sheets. All prices are fully inclusive, per person per night and include accommodation, all meals & beverages, guest laundry, transfer between Mowe Bay and Shipwreck Lodge, park entry permit and daily activities and excursions. Premium brand drinks, Curios, transfers between Shipwreck Lodge and Hoanib Valley Camp, accompanied transfers between Mowe Bay and Shipwreck Lodge and Shipwreck Lodge and Leylandsdrift, gratuities and fully comprehensive personal travel insurance are not included in nightly rate.

Over and above the 1.5% included in our turnover that is collected on behalf of Conservation and Community Trusts we have introduced a per person per night Conservation, Community and Reserve Fee of **NAD 650.00**. This non-refundable fee secures funds that are crucial to our areas of operation for the protecting wildlife habitats, supporting communities as well as managing reserves and concessions. Uses include anti-poaching patrols, wildlife monitoring, community upliftment and royalties, human-wildlife conflict mitigation, land management and conservation education. The Conservation Community and Reserve Fee is not applicable for children aged 0-5 years, but does apply to children 6 years and older as well as pilots/guides.  45 - 31 days before travel 25% cancellation fee

ROAD TRANSFERS: Transfers depart from Mowe Bay at 11:00 and 15:00 for the lodge and depart from the lodge to Mowe Bay at around 09:00 to arrive by 11:00. Road transfers between Shipwreck Lodge and Leylandsdrift are charged at **NAD 3,464.00 per person each way**.
