



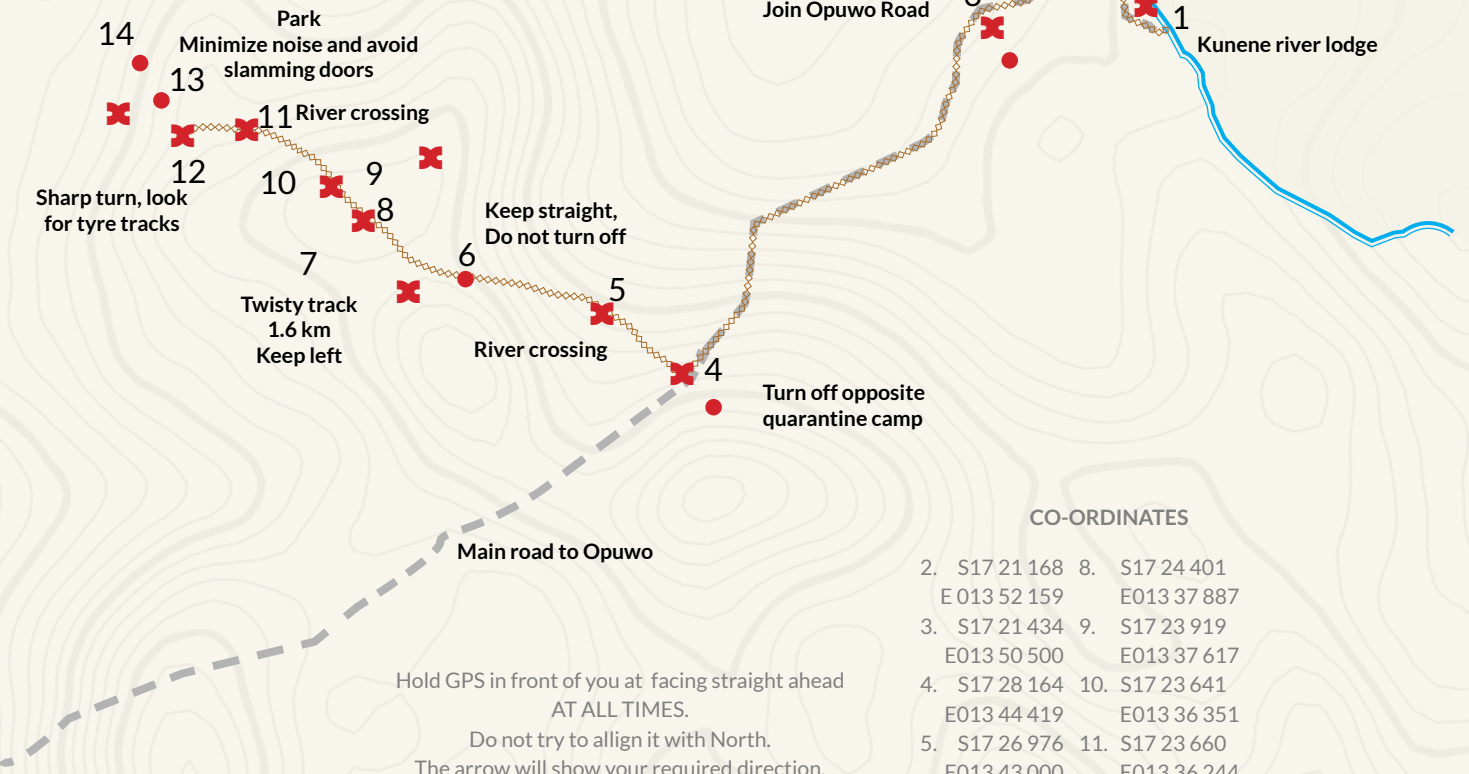
Kunene River Lodge

Notes

1. Kunene River Lodge
2. Turn Left
3. Turn Left Towards Opuwo
4. Turn Right At Quarantine Camp
5. Ondoto River Crossing
6. Don't Be Tempted To 'Follow' Round Round To Left
7. Don't Be Tempted To Take Rische Forig
8. Sharp Dip - If Water At Botch - Try For Cinderella On Way Back (10H00-11H00)
9. Small Hill To Your Right. Is Possible Habitat For A.c.c But Keep Going To The Main Mountains
10. Himba Kraal
11. Etansa River Crossing - If Any Doubt, Walk It First
12. Difficult To See, Watch Gps Carfully And Look For Tyre Tracks
13. Parking Spot, 1.6Km From Turn Off
14. Walk Up To This Spot. Sit Still And Quietly Looking 'Up' Rock Face

Walk up to rocks to this point - sit quietly and still. GOOD LUCK
